



TEN DAY INTERFAITH ITINERARY

BETH SHOLOM B'NAI ISRAEL TRIP MARCH 4 – 15 , 2018

March 4 – Sunday – Departure to Israel.

March 5 – Monday - Day 1 – Arrival to Israel. Dinner and first night in Tel Aviv.

March 6 – Tuesday - Day 2 – Visit Independence Hall, the site of the signing of Israel's Declaration of Independence and continue to HaPalmach Museum (or Rabin Center). Tour of downtown Tel Aviv, stopping at Nachlat Binyamin Arts&Crafts Fair. From there proceed to Visit the old city of Jaffa (Yafo) and the old port. Dinner and second night in Tel Aviv.

March 7 – Wednesday - Day 3 – Departing Tel Aviv en route to Jerusalem. Arrive to Jerusalem and stop at the Hass Promenade for a breathtaking view of Jerusalem and the Shehecheyanu prayer of gratitude. Continue to the Old City visiting the Jewish, Christian and Muslim quarters (including the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, Via Dolorosa). Visit Mt. Zion (one mountain serving three religions). Check into the hotel. Dinner and first night in Jerusalem.

March 8 – Thursday - Day 4 – After breakfast, visit the Kotel (Western Wall) and the Western Wall Tunnels. Volunteer at Yad L'kashish. Early afternoon free time to shop at the Cardo or at Ben Yehuda Street shops. Dinner followed by Tower of David Light Show. Second night in Jerusalem.

March 9 – Friday - Day 5 – Visit to the Yad Vashem complex and the adjacent Mt. Hertzl. From there volunteering at Yad Sarah. Shabbat dinner at hotel. Dinner and third night in Jerusalem.

March 10 – Saturday -Day 6 – Shabbat services. Rest of day at Leisure. We will have recommended walking tours in the Old City and other locations (visit to the Israel Museum). Dinner and fourth night in Jerusalem.

March 11 – Sunday - Day 7 – Drive South to Masada, a fortress built by Herods the Great, sieged by troops of the Roman Empire and ended in a mass suicide. Continuing to the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth. Dinner and last night in Jerusalem.

March 12– Monday – Day 8 - Check-out from hotel and drive North. Stop at Beit Shean. Continue to Nazareth/Church of Annunciation, Jacob's Well. Dinner, first night in Tiberias.

March 13 – Tuesday - Day 9 - Visit Christian holy sites around the Sea of Galilee including: The Mount of Beatitudes, Tabgha-the Church of the Multiplication, Capernaum. Enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, ending in Ginosar to visit the ancient boat. Dinner, second night in Tiberias.

March 14– Wednesday – Day 10 – Early check out from hotel and drive to Safed, considered one of Judaism's four holy cities and center of Kabbalah. Continue to Akko (Acre) where four religions have made their home. From there drive South and visit Caesarea. Farewell dinner and last overnight in Tel Aviv.

March 15 – Thursday - Day 11 – Transfer to the airport and flight back to the USA.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

RESERVATION AND PAYMENTS: All reservation forms must be accompanied by a deposit of \$500 per person. Checks should be made payable to Galilee Travel, Inc.

LAND ARRANGEMENTS: Sightseeing is included through the duration of our trip. We feature hotels specifically selected for our tours. Occasionally we are obliged to make substitutions. All hotels offer us standard grade (run of the house) rooms. Package is based on double occupancy. Single rooms are often limited. If arrangements for roommates have not been made by February 15th, 2018, the single supplement of \$924.00 will then be required.

AIR ARRANGEMENTS: Package includes airfare. Please note that airport taxes and fuel surcharges are included in the air price and are subject to change.

MEALS: Arranged meals are detailed in the itinerary.

TRANSFERS: Transfers are offered based on our itinerary. Passengers arriving and departing not per our trip's schedule are responsible for their own transfers.

TIPPING: Tips for guide, bus driver, restaurants hotels –**are additional** - \$120 per person recommended.

INSURANCE: Insurance is not included in any tour package. **INSURANCE IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.** Please note that we cannot accept responsibility for any losses or expenses which you or any member of your party may incur as a result of failing to secure adequate coverage. Galilee Travel recommends Travelex Insurance. Please see attached Travelex form and ask us for details.

MEDICAL CONDITION: Galilee Travel is not responsible for any medical conditions that may occur prior, during, or after the tour. Please let us know about any special health or dietary consideration including physical limitations and allergies. Although we will do our best to accommodate them, these are ultimately the responsibility of the traveler.

PASSPORT AND VISAS: A valid passport is required for all participants. It must be valid for 6 months from the day of your return to the US or the airline may refuse you boarding. There is no Visa requirement for citizens of the USA travelling to Israel. Other nationals should contact the appropriate consulate for regulations.

CANCELLATION FEES: Cancellations must be received in writing and signed by the client.

- \$100 if cancelled after December 1st, 2017
- \$250 if cancelled after January 1st, 2018
- There will be no refunds if cancelled after February 1st, 2018.

BAGGAGE: Travelers are limited to one large suitcase per person plus a carry on. Airlines are constantly updating their luggage requirements and policies and we strongly advise that you check with your airline before departure in order to avoid additional charges. Luggage is the responsibility of the passenger. For

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lost luggage claims, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Baggage insurance is recommended and is included in the Travelex coverage we recommend.

MEALS: Full breakfast and dinner are included every day.

NOT INCLUDED: Meals or beverages other than breakfast and dinner each day; airport taxes, optional tours, charges for passports, visas, laundry, liquor, excess baggage charges, accident and baggage insurance, telephone or cable charges, private non-group transfer, items of a personal nature and any items not specifically listed as included.

RESPONSIBILITY: Galilee Travel is acting solely as an intermediary agent for the travel suppliers providing means of transportation, hotel and/or all other related travel services being purchased (the "Third Party Providers"). Galilee Travel therefore, shall not be liable or responsible for any injury, illness, loss or damage to any person or property or additional expense involved with travel resulting from acts of God, detention, annoyance, delays, quarantine, strikes, thefts, pilferage, force majeure, diseases, mechanical difficulties, failure of any means of transportation to arrive or depart as scheduled, civil disturbances, terrorism, government restrictions or regulations, and discrepancies or changes in transportation or hotel services or any other matter or event over which Galilee Travel has no control; or for any state of quality, hygiene, political, stability, cuisine, sanitation facilities, cleanliness, telecommunications facilities, methods of conducting business, emergency medical evacuation, treatment or medical services existing at any travel destination. By embarking upon his/her travel, the passenger voluntarily assumes all risks involved with such travel, whether expected or unexpected. The issuance and acceptance of any exchange orders or tickets shall constitute consent by the purchase and/or passenger to the foregoing conditions. All exchange orders and tickets are also subject to such additional terms and conditions as the Third Party Providers may impose. Finally, Galilee Travel shall not be liable for any funds received from the purchaser and/or passenger and paid over to any Third Party Provider which subsequently becomes insolvent or files any bankruptcy or similar proceedings or fails to deliver services.

Delays, cancellations and overbooking by participating Third Party Providers may occur on air flights and land reservations. While Galilee Travel will do its utmost to avoid these inconveniences, it shall not be liable or responsible for the acts or omissions of such Third Party Providers.

Galilee Travel reserves the right (i) to cancel any tour, substitute hotels and make such alterations in tour itineraries as may be necessary or desirable for the convenience of the parties and the proper carrying out of the tour; and (ii) to decline to accept or retain any person as a member of any tour. All additional cost, if necessary, shall be the passenger's responsibility. In addition, Galilee Travel may cancel any tour prior to departure. In such a case, a full refund of all payments will constitute full settlement with the passenger and/or purchaser of the tour.
